Background

Grasslands **Prospect** is a new-generation perennial ryegrass that has been bred from a combination of genetics derived from late-heading north-west Spanish perennial ryegrass and traditional mid-season heading perennial ryegrasses. Part of its genetic selection came from plants selected for Aluminum tolerance. Due to **Prospect's** flowering date of +12 days, its peak spring growth is situated between a late-heading ryegrass such as One50 and mid-season heading perennial ryegrass like Samson.

Prospect is characterised by a dense fine-leaved habit. One of its main strengths is its reliable all-year-round production.

Prospect has shown excellent adaptation to a wide range of environments ranging from hill country to highly productive dairy pastures.

Prospect's strong seedling vigour and high autumn yields with solid year round performance provides an ideal combination for most ryegrass zones. The densely tillered, fine leaf nature of **Prospect's** diploid characteristics enable it to recover from hard grazing once established which has led to good persistence under tough conditions.

Prospect has been bred, selected and successfully tested as a perennial and will function as a perennial ryegrass. Due to a small number of tip awns **Prospect** is certified as *Lolium boucheanum*.
